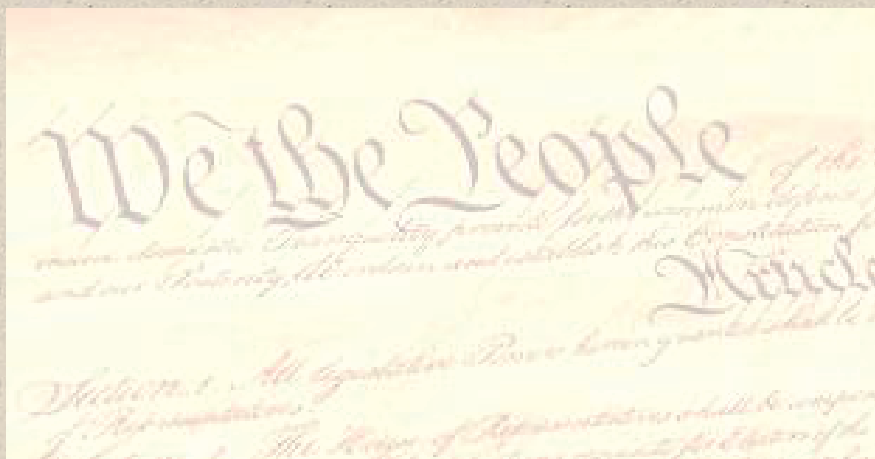

The Constitution of WONDERLAND

(Preamble)

We WONDERLAND People, in Order to form an Ideal Country, and establish Justice in it , insure domestic Tranquility, provide for the common defence, promote the general Welfare, and secure the Blessings of Liberty to ourselves and our Posterity, do ordain and establish this Constitution for WONDERLAND.

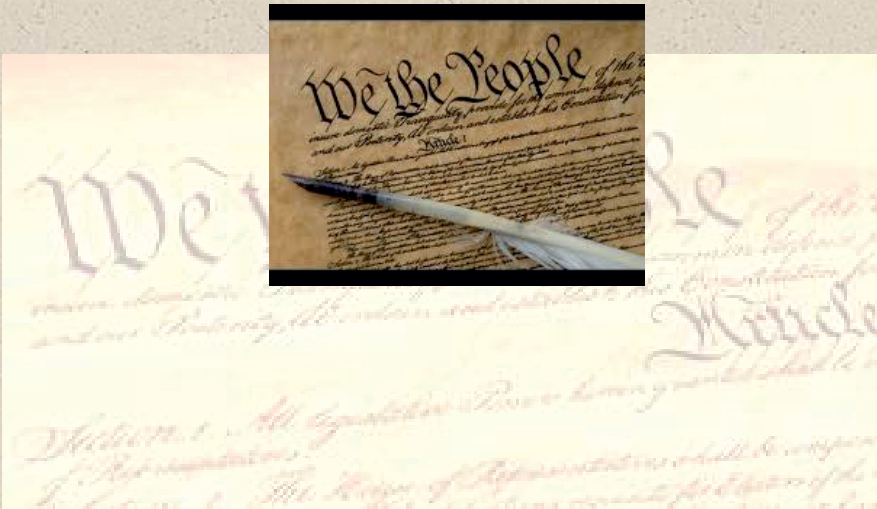

ARTICLE 1

Human rights

THE FOLLOWING RIGHTS, DERIVING FROM THE EUROPEAN CONVENTION ON HUMAN RIGHTS AND EXPRESSED IN THE HUMAN RIGHTS ACT, ARE AVAILABLE WITHOUT QUALIFICATION TO ALL PERSONS WITHIN WONDERLAND:

EVERYONE HAS THE RIGHT TO LIFE;

-EVERYONE HAS THE RIGHT TO BE FREE FROM TORTURE, INHUMAN OR DEGRADING TREATMENT;

-EVERYONE HAS THE RIGHT TO BE FREE FROM SLAVERY AND FORCED LABOUR;

-THE RIGHT TO LIBERTY AND FREEDOM FROM ARBITRARY ARREST AND DETENTION;

- THE RIGHT TO A FAIR TRIAL;

-THE RIGHT TO RESPECT FOR PRIVATE AND FAMILY LIFE, HOME AND CORRESPONDENCE;

-THE RIGHT TO FREEDOM OF THOUGHT, CONSCIENCE AND RELIGION; THE RIGHT TO FREEDOM OF EXPRESSION;

- THE RIGHT TO FREEDOM OF ASSEMBLY AND ASSOCIATION;

- THE RIGHT TO MARRY AND FOUND A FAMILY;

-THE RIGHT TO PEACEFUL POSSESSION OF PROPERTY;

-THE RIGHT TO EDUCATION;

-THE RIGHT TO TAKE PART IN FREE AND FAIR ELECTIONS, HELD AT REGULAR INTERVALS.

ARTICLE 2

Responsibilities

EVERY CITIZEN OF WONDERLAND SHOULD RESPECT FOLLOWING RESPONSIBILITIES:

- SUPPORT AND DEFEND THE CONSTITUTION.
- STAY INFORMED OF THE ISSUES AFFECTING YOUR COMMUNITY.
- PARTICIPATE IN THE DEMOCRATIC PROCESS.
- RESPECT AND OBEY FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL LAWS.
- RESPECT THE RIGHTS, BELIEFS, AND OPINIONS OF OTHERS.
- PARTICIPATE IN YOUR LOCAL COMMUNITY.
- PAY INCOME AND OTHER TAXES HONESTLY, AND ON TIME, TO FEDERAL, STATE, AND LOCAL AUTHORITIES.
- DEFEND THE COUNTRY IF THE NEED SHOULD ARISE.



ARTICLE 3

Obligations

OBLIGATIONS IMPLY MORAL RESPONSIBILITIES TO THE COUNTRY AND FELLOW CITIZENS IN RESPONSE TO HAVING THE PRIVILEGES OF CITIZENSHIP.

THOSE OBLIGATIONS INCLUDE

- BEING A VOLUNTEER AND ADDRESSING THE SPECIAL NEEDS OF OUR COMMUNITIES.
- BEING A GOOD NEIGHBOR AND ENSURING THE SAFETY AND CLEANLINESS OF BOTH OUR NEIGHBORHOODS AND OUR WORKPLACES.
- BEING A GOOD WONDERLANDER BY LIVING THE PRINCIPLES AND VALUES CONSISTENT WITH THOSE IMPLIED IN THE CONSTITUTION: INTEGRITY, SELF-DISCIPLINE, PROACTIVITY, HUMILITY AND EMPATHY.



ARTICLE 4 Legislative

THE HEAD OF STATE OF WONDERLAND IS THE PRESIDENT.

- AN ELECTION FOR PRESIDENT OF WONDERLAND OCCURS EVERY FOUR YEARS ON ELECTION DAY.
- DURING THE GENERAL ELECTION, WONDERLAND CITIZENS HEAD TO THE POLLS TO CAST THEIR VOTE FOR PRESIDENT. TO WIN THE ELECTION, A CANDIDATE MUST RECEIVE A MAJORITY OF ELECTORAL VOTES.

THE PRESIDENT MUST:

- BE A NATURAL - BORN CITIZEN OF WONDERLAND
- BE AT LEAST 24 YEARS OLD

THE PRESIDENT-ELECT RECITES THE FOLLOWING OATH, IN ACCORDANCE WITH WONDERLAND CONSTITUTION:

"I do solemnly swear that I will faithfully execute the office of President of Wonderland, and will to the best of my ability, preserve, protect and defend the Constitution of my country."



ARTICLE 5

Punishment

- PUNISHMENT MUST BE FAIR AND EQUAL.
- THERE MUST BE NO ESCAPE FROM THE PUNISHMENT.

CRIMES ARE PUNISHED ACCORDING TO THE SERIOUSNESS OF THE ACT, AND OFTEN TAKE INTO CONSIDERATION THE PRIOR CRIMINAL HISTORY OF THE DEFENDANT.

- THERE ARE FOUR TYPES OF PUNISHMENT:

- * FINE - EITHER IN TRAFFIC INFRACTIONS OR NON-VIOLENT VIOLATIONS OF CRIMINAL LAWS.
- * PROBATION - CERTAIN CONDITIONS ARE IMPOSED ON THE CONVICTED PERSON'S RELEASE
- * INCARCERATION - THE OFFENDER IS HELD IN CUSTODY IN PRISON
- * COMMUNITY SERVICE - THE PERSON IS ASSIGNED TO WORK IN A FACILITY IN NEED OF VOLUNTEER WORKERS. SOUP KITCHENS, PUBLIC PARKS, COMMUNITY CENTERS AND PUBLICLY OPERATED HOSPITALS ARE SOME OF THE FACILITIES IN WHICH A PERSON WOULD WORK FOR THE NUMBER OF HOURS.

FOURTH DAY OF APRIL IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD TWO THOUSAND AND SEVENTEEN.
